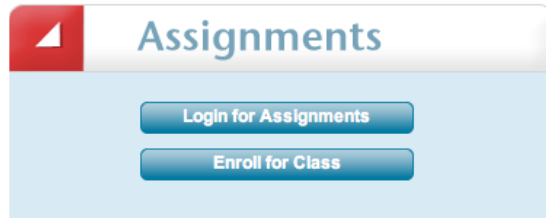


HOW TO USE SMARTMUSIC ASSESSMENT

Step 1: Doubleclick Smartmusic



Step 2: Click Assignments then “Login for Assignments”



Step 3: Enter Email address and Password

Step 7: You can listen to your take, then submit it or try again.
